Dear Parents and Guardians,

Accompanying this letter you will find details of our Term 1 Extra-Curricular Programme incorporating a range of teacher-led classroom activities, academic classes and our FOBISSEA training sessions for the U15 FOBISSEA Games this term. In addition to supporting learning in the classroom and developing a wider range of interests, many of these clubs are designed to encourage a healthy lifestyle and a zest for life.

Clubs require participants to make a serious commitment and therefore we ask all students and their families to think very carefully about their choices before applying. Attendance registers will be taken for every session and club leaders must be informed if a student is unable to attend. Please note that **unexplained absences** will result in the offer of a place being withdrawn.

There are a minimum number of five students required for each club to run. Please note however that numbers are limited too for most of our clubs and most places will be filled on a first come, first served basis, although we do try to ensure that everyone gets at least one of their first-choice options. The completed 'Student Return Form' should be returned to the main school office no later than **Wednesday, 1st September 2010**. All places will be confirmed as soon as possible thereafter. To be fair to all those who kindly contribute to our programme, we are unable to accept any applications for the Term 1 programme after this date.

The Primary and Secondary Extra-curricular Programmes will start in the week beginning Monday, 6th September. **Mandarin** classes will begin in the week beginning **Monday 13th September**. New families should register at the main school office before this date and arrange to speak with Helen Yee to confirm which level their child will join. Details of groups and times will be displayed on the noticeboard outside the school office. Saturday **French** classes will also continue this term. If you would like to enroll your child, please do so at the school office. These classes are intended for Malaysian students who must by law study Bahasa Malaysia during school curriculum time and therefore have no opportunity to opt for French. However, we do accept non-Malaysians providing that there are spaces in the class and it is clearly understood that Malaysian students have priority.
