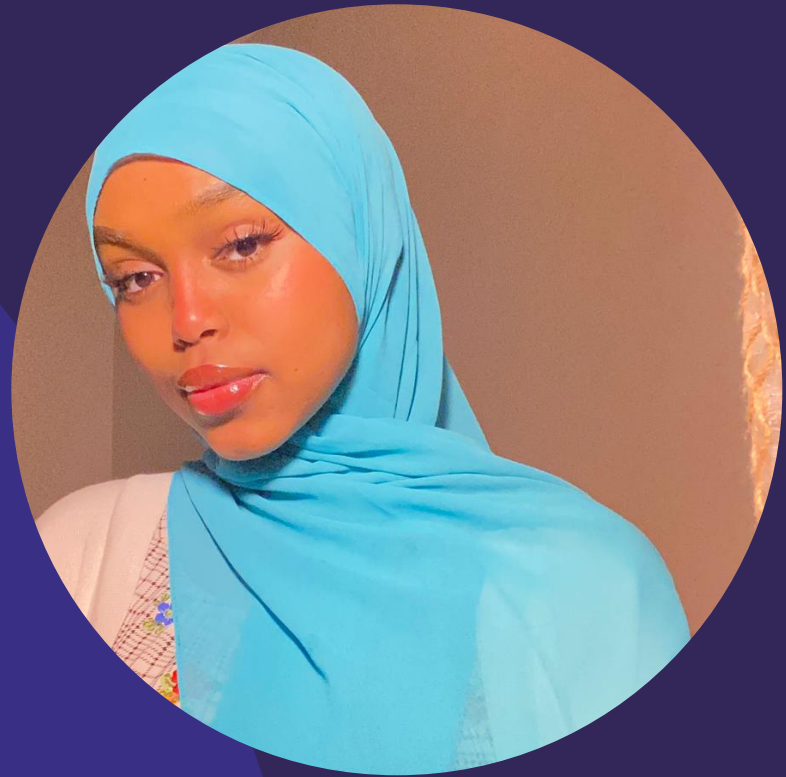
ALYA ARIFFIN
